She was a full scholarship student at the Banff International Centre for the Performing Arts where she studied with Marek Jablonski and later completed two years of further studies with Lee Kum-Sing, again at UBC. She has been a BC Registered Music Teacher for the past 30 years and served several terms on the South Fraser branch executive council and festival committees. In an attempt to make music accessible and affordable to her local community, Catherine has also hosted more than 35 "house concerts" in her home featuring performing artists from universities and music schools. Catherine is a member of the Canadian Music Festival Adjudicators' Association and has given classes and workshops throughout the province. She is also a member of the Royal Conservatory of Music, College of Examiners, and presently maintains a private studio in Surrey, BC.
