Praised for her "effortless lyric soprano of sumptuous beauty with perfect diction, and a graceful, expressive stage presence", Eve-Lyn de la Haye has made her mark among the Canadian sopranos of her generation. Ms de la Haye has performed leading roles with Vancouver Opera, Pacific Opera Victoria, and Calgary Opera. She is a frequent soloist with the Victoria Symphony, Vancouver Symphony Orchestra, the Vancouver Bach Choir, and the West Coast Symphony.

Ms de la Haye is a graduate of the Victoria Conservatory of Music and the University of Toronto's Opera Division and is an alumna of the Aldeburgh Festival, the Tanglewood Music Festival, the International Vocal Arts Institute, and the Banff Centre for the Performing Arts. She has represented the GVPAF in Provincial and National Voice, and is a Rosebowl winner and former competitor in the Roberto and Mary Wood Scholarship Competition. Ms de la Haye settled in East Vancouver in 2013 with her husband and two young children where she is also a teaching artist for Vancouver Opera.
