Toni Stanick has worn many hats throughout her extensive career. Currently a member of the Vancouver Opera and Film Orchestras, she has appeared onstage as an orchestral, chamber and solo violinist, in the studio recording for film, television and on disc, with legends including Michael Buble, Bryan Adams and Diana Krall. As a composer, she has written works for chamber orchestra, solo violin and modern dance. Her work as composer/performer for the ballet *La Beaute du Diable* toured Canada and the Cannes International Festival of Dance to critical acclaim. Her passion as an educator has led to students winning full scholarships to Juilliard, Colburn, Shulich, U of BC and U of Victoria Schools of Music, being broadcast nationally on CBC and King FM, as well as garnering trophies and scholarships at Municipal, Provincial and National competitions and festivals. Her graduates perform in major orchestras world-wide. She has acted in the role of adjudicator throughout British Columbia. In 2010 she launched JOY of MUSIC, a benefit concert designed to showcase outstanding student talent and develop philanthropy in youth. The JOY initiative, in 4 concerts, raised funds of close to \$14,000 for the research and treatment of childhood cancer.
