Joslin Romphf Dennis, soprano, holds a Bachelor of Music in Voice and Master of Music in Opera Performance from the prestigious Curtis Institute of Music in Philadelphia, and is a graduate of the renowned Lindeman Young Artist Development Program at the Metropolitan Opera in New York City. She has sung at many prestigious venues, like the Metropolitan Opera and Carnegie Hall, and under the baton of James Levine, Mario Bernardi, Maurizio Barbacini, and Valery Ghergiev, to name a few. Ms. Romphf Dennis made her Canadian operatic debut singing Elettra in Pacific Opera Victoria's production of Idomeneo. She was presented in her New York City solo recital debut by the Marilyn Horne Foundation, and has participated in numerous summer festivals, including Glimmerglass Opera, the Ravinia Festival and the Marlboro Festival. She was the recipient of a Vancouver Opera Guild Grant, and was the winner of the Canadian Opera Company's Young Canadian Mozart Singers competition. She is an ardent interpreter of art song and an enthusiastic opera and concert performer. After 5 years teaching out of her private studio in Montreal, Ms. Romphf Dennis is currently on the voice faculty of the Vancouver Academy of Music.
