Thomas Williams

A Canadian Violinist, Thomas Williams is a former Associate Professor of Violin and Chamber Music at the Schulich School of Music of McGill University. He has also held positions as first violinist with the Montreal Symphony and as Assistant Concert Master of the Hamburg Symphony Orchestra. As a chamber musician, he has been a member of the Montreal String Quartet and a founding member of the Concord Chamber Ensemble, and has appeared as a guest artist across Canada. In addition to an active performing career as a violinist and violist, Mr. Williams is a well-known adjudicator, and a jury member. He has for many years worked with the National Orchestra of Canada, and has participated as a performer and teacher at numerous other music festivals in Canada including Orford and the International Music Institute. Prof. Williams teaching association with McGill began in 1981. He assumed the position of String Area Chair in 1986, where he has been instrumental in developing a highly successful string program at McGill University.
