Vincent Roy began playing piano at 8 years old and studied with Suzanne Beaubien-Lowe at the Quebec City Music Conservatory until the age of 14. After playing trumpet in high school, he developed an affinity for the tuba and completed a Bachelor degree in music performance at Laval University, QC under the tutelage of Lance Nagels. He then performed regularly with the Orchestre Symphonique de Québec, the Ensemble Vents & Percussions de Québec and many other professional ensembles. Vincent Roy joined the Canadian Armed Forces as a reservist in 2001 and performed with La Musique du NCSM Montcalm and La Musique des Voltigeurs de Québec until being offered in 2006, a regular force position. Posted to La Musique du Royal 22e Régiment in Valcartier, QC, he performed in venues all around the world. Having an avid interest in conducting, he studied with Maestro Gilles Auger before being selected to become bandmaster of the 14 Wing Band in Greenwood, NS. In July 2015, he accepted his commission and completed the one-year long Music Officer Course where he had the pleasure to study with Dr. Gillian Mackay at University of Toronto. In July 2016, Vincent Roy moved to Victoria, BC and became the 21st Music Director and Commanding Officer of the NADEN Band of the Royal Canadian Navy.
