

CLASSICAL GUITAR

The date for Classical Guitar is April 17, 2019.

Classical Guitar will be part of a Highlights Concert on May 2, 2019 with Woodwinds, Brass and Composition Sections.

Note that in order to qualify for awards and Provincial consideration, performance in two solo classes is required. Note that the new Jazz/Contemporary solo classes do **not** qualify as one of the classes for Provincial consideration.

Repeats are optional for all classes, providing the performance does not exceed maximum time limits.

Repertoire will appear on the adjudication sheets exactly as input on the registration form by the registrant. Therefore, it is important that the spelling, punctuation and composer's name be as accurate as possible. Festival staff and Section Heads will **not** make any corrections to the repertoire as input by the registrant.

Note: Changes to repertoire are permitted only after approval by the Section Head, however any change in repertoire cannot exceed the original performance time.

Provincial and National Recommendation

The Provincial Festival has changed the upper age limit to enter at the Senior level to '23 and under'. This means if you are 24 or older you WILL NOT qualify for Provincials in the Senior level.

Please refer to Provincial and National Syllabi available on their websites for specific rules. Note that memorization is mandatory for the National Class at both Provincial and National Festivals.

Chamber Ensembles and Recommendation to the Provincial and National Festivals

For the purpose of awards and Provincial consideration, participants in ensemble classes are NOT required to adhere to the 'two solo class' requirement.

The Provincial Festival has only one Section for all ensembles. Local festivals can send two ensembles to each Provincial level: Junior, Intermediate and Senior, and two ensembles to the National level. The appropriate level is determined by the group's AVERAGE AGE but no player can be more than 23 years old. The **average age** of Provincial Senior level ensembles must not exceed 23 years. Four instrumental Sections in the local Festival offer classes for chamber ensembles. The following process allows adjudication of ensembles in their own discipline and also provides an opportunity for a playoff when more than two ensembles at the same level are eligible for recommendation to the Provincial Festival.

Procedure:

1. Ensembles will be adjudicated by specialists in their own discipline.
2. Ensembles who meet Provincial criteria will be informed by the Section Head.
3. When ensembles at the same level and from different disciplines wish to proceed to the Provincial Festival, the GVPFAFA will arrange a playoff.
4. Adjudicators for a playoff will be musicians, such as orchestra conductors, with knowledge of and experience in working with all orchestral instruments.

CLASSICAL GUITAR CLASSES

NOTE - Participants who wish to be considered for recommendation to the Provincial or National Festivals must enter at least **two** solo classes in their level - **not** including 'accompanied' and **not** including the new Jazz/Contemporary classes* as neither is a Provincial level class.

GUITAR ENSEMBLES

The appropriate age category is determined by the AVERAGE age of the players. No player in the Junior, Intermediate and Senior categories may be over 23 years of age, 28 for National Class. In order to be considered for recommendation to the Provincial or National Festivals, ensembles must have a minimum of 3 players.

NOTE - All players will be adjudicated. Solo players with accompanists should enter "accompanied" classes listed above.
