TIME LIMITS

Teachers and performers are <u>required</u> to time their pieces accurately and keep within the assigned time limits. Failure to observe these limits may result in a performer being disqualified from receiving an award. It is <u>imperative</u> that the accurate time is listed on your registration.

PHOTOCOPYING

The Festival will strictly enforce its policy of not allowing unauthorized photocopies to be used in the Festival classes, either by the accompanists, performers or for the adjudicator's music (See Rules and Regulations). To be authorized, the performer must have written permission from the owner of the copyright. Music downloaded from imslp.org is permitted. Please include the full URL of the work being performed on the first page of all parts and copies being used.

Note: Repertoire will appear on the adjudication sheets exactly as input by the registrant. Therefore, it is important that the spelling, punctuation and composer's name be as accurate as possible. Festival staff and Section Heads will not make any corrections to the repertoire as input by the registrant.

Note: Changes to repertoire are permitted only after approval by the Section Head; however, any change in repertoire must not exceed the original performance time.

SPECIAL RULES: (See also General Rules and Regulations)

- 1. Participants may register in classes for higher age levels, keeping in mind Rule 6 under Festival Rules: Eligibility: "When age groups and/or playing levels are specified, participants may enter only in **one** category in that section.
- 2. For all string classes the instrumental RCM most current syllabus edition is the reference to determine level category. If your selection is not in the RCM current exam syllabus, the candidate shall submit an approval request to the GVPAF prior to registration.
- 3. Age Categories for Strings: (age is as of December 31, 2023)

Junior A - 14 years and under, beginner to level 8 included.

Exception is the Recital Group which is level 6 to 8.

Junior B - 14 years and under, level 9 and above.

Intermediate - 15 to 17 years old

Senior – 18 to 23 years old. Participants wishing to be considered for the Provincial Festival must be 22 years of age and under.

Adult – Over 23 years old

Adults will not be eligible to be sent to the Provincial Festival, nor generally for awards. Participants up to 30 years old may be eligible to be recommended to the National Festival Qualifying Round.

- 4. Repeat signs are permitted, providing the performance does not exceed maximum time limits.
- 5. Selections must fit the time limits given. It is <u>imperative</u> that the accurate time is listed on your registration.
- 6. Selections must not be repeated by the same player in successive years.
- 7. Players must announce their selections before performing.

- 8. All string adjudicators will keep private records for the purpose of selecting award and scholarships recipients and candidates to the Provincial and National Festivals.
- 9. To be eligible for recommendation to the Provincial and National Festivals or for local awards, participants must enter at least two solo classes. Note: Any of classes "Violin, Viola, Cello or Bass", and "Recital Group" is considered one solo class.
- 10. Memorization: To be eligible for Provincial or National Festivals memorization of repertoire is compulsory. Excluded are Sonata, Chamber Music and Duet classes.
- 11. The first movement of a Concerto or Sonata may **only** be played in the Concerto or Sonata classes. Other movements can be played in these classes or other relevant classes (i.e., era classes).
- 12. Performers in the String classes may use any piano accompanist, amateur or professional. Please note, however, in those Duet Classes where both parts will be adjudicated, age restrictions apply and the pianist may not be a professional. Exception: Baroque style playing see rule 14
- 13. Baroque playing style classes, solo and ensembles: Use of a baroque bow is compulsory. Gut strings or baroque instrument not a requirement but strongly encouraged. Continuo is the preferred accompaniment as the GVPAF will not provide, move or tune a harpsichord. Baroque Classes and Ensembles are not qualifying for Provincials or Nationals.
- 14. Double bass players will be accommodated on an individual basis in any class. Contact Section Head for details.
- 15. The Adjudicator's decision is final.

PROVINCIAL FESTIVAL RECOMMENDATION

Participants must enter at least two solo classes in order to be eligible for recommendation to the Provincial or National Festival. The Adjudicator will consider number of classes entered, display of knowledge of various styles of music, and standard of accomplishment when making recommendations.

ENSEMBLES/DUET: For the purpose of awards and Provincial/National consideration, participants in those classes are NOT required to adhere to the 'two solo classes' requirement.

Chamber Ensembles

At the present time, The Provincial Festival has only one section for ensembles.

Chamber Music (3 to 9 performers; 3 to 6 performers in the Provincial Excellence class.) The appropriate level is determined by the group's AVERAGE AGE but no player can be more than 22 years old. Four instrumental sections in the local Festival offer classes for chamber ensembles. The following process allows adjudication of ensembles in their own discipline and also provides an opportunity for a playoff when more than two ensembles at the same level are eligible for recommendation to the Provincial Festival.

Please note:

- 1. Ensembles will be adjudicated by specialists in their own discipline.
- 2. Ensembles who meet Provincial criteria will be informed by the Section Head.
- 3. When ensembles at the same level and from different disciplines wish to proceed to the Provincial Festival, the GVPAFA will arrange a playoff.

Adjudicators for a playoff will be musicians, such as orchestra conductors, with knowledge of and experience in working with all orchestral instruments

Duet classes:

One instrument must be a violin, viola, cello or bass; the other instrument must be any other recognized orchestral instrument, including piano and harp. Both performers will be adjudicated. Competitors must register in the level of the oldest performer and no competitor may be over 22 years of age for Provincials consideration.

Pease note: As the number of performers includes piano if accompaniment is used, works for two instruments and piano would be considered trios.

CANADA WEST FESTIVAL

BC participants in this Festival will be chosen by the adjudicators from performances at the BC Provincial Festival. For more information, please see the syllabus at www.bcprovincials.com/canada-west-festival.aspx

NATIONAL FESTIVAL QUALIFYING STREAM RECOMMENDATIONS

Participants must enter at least two solo classes to be eligible for recommendation to the National Festival. Please register in the appropriate classes for your age. The Adjudicator will consider the number of classes entered, display of knowledge of various styles of music, and standard of accomplishment when making recommendations. Please see the FCMF website for classes available in 2024.

The National Festival <u>Emerging Artist</u> upper age limit is '30 and under' as of December 31 preceding the Festival.

The National Festival <u>Developing Artist</u> upper age limit is '18 and under' as of December 31 preceding the Festival.

The National Festival Non-Competitive Education Stream upper age limit is '18 and under' as of December 31 preceding the Festival.

Chamber Ensembles

Local festivals can send one ensemble (3 to 9 players) to every level of the LSQR Ensemble Stream at the National Festival. The **maximum age of any performer is 30 years old**.

For the purpose of awards and National consideration, participants in ensemble classes are NOT required to adhere to the 'two solo class' requirement.

- 1. Ensembles who meet National criteria will be informed by the Section Head.
- 2. When ensembles at the same level and from different disciplines wish to proceed to the National Festival, the GVPAFA will arrange a playoff.
- 3. Adjudicators for a playoff will be musicians, such as orchestra conductors, with knowledge of and experience in working with all orchestral instruments.
